It's Time for Some FAQs...

Over the past few weeks, we have answered many questions sent to SAAC HQ by email and text messages. Here are the top questions and their answers...

I've never been to this event and have never been to Road Atlanta, what do I need to know about the facilities?

It can answer many facility questions. Remember, we are a private event; many of the rules for big name events will not apply to us. Also, you will get a handy pocket SAAC Convention Guide at the Track to help locate things.

I am just running Parade Laps; does my car need to be inspected and do I need to follow Open Track guidelines

No, you will run Parade Laps at a safe highway speed.

Can I bring a canopy to set up as a spectator to have some shade during the event?

Absolutely. Georgia in August? no problem with cabana or small canopy for shade

Can I bring food or non-alcoholic beverages with me to the event?

Yes, you may . You are correct with "no alcohol." But, you may bring a cooler of food and drinks..We also will have quite a few food trucks there.

Are portable chairs a must to bring?

I think that's a great idea if you plan to watch the track action

I am just coming for one day to see the cars, do I still need to pay for admission?

Yes, All non-show or race cars need to pay a Track Admission fee and sign a waiver at the Gate

Can I view the race cars up close (paddock area)?

The Paddock (Race car pits) is open to all guests; you are free to stroll around and see the participants up close. For on-track action, there are many viewing areas all around the facility, from grassy areas to seatings. Feel free to find a favorite spot

I'm transporting a car for a friend of mine to the event. Is there adequate parking for car haulers?

Without a doubt. There are four trailer parking lots; you may load in on Thursday, between Noon and 6:00pm

Is there a fee for trailer parking?

The only fee for entry is the Gate Admission fee; \$50 per person for 3-day pass, \$20 for a single day. No parking fees.

Is there overnight parking for trailers and would there be security and or a fee for that?

You may park the trailer overnight and through the weekend. You will not have access after 6:00pm. The track is locked down after that, with 24 hour security

I signed up for Parade Laps and Autocross. Where do I get my tickets?

Parade Lap passes will be in your packet; Autocross tickets are retrieved at the MCA Tent

Is there infield parking and viewing of the races from there?

Non-display or race cars will all park in designated guest areas

Where are the better places to view the races (what turns, grand stands etc.)?

That's up to you ... review the color Track map on the Road Atlanta website for highlighted areas.
