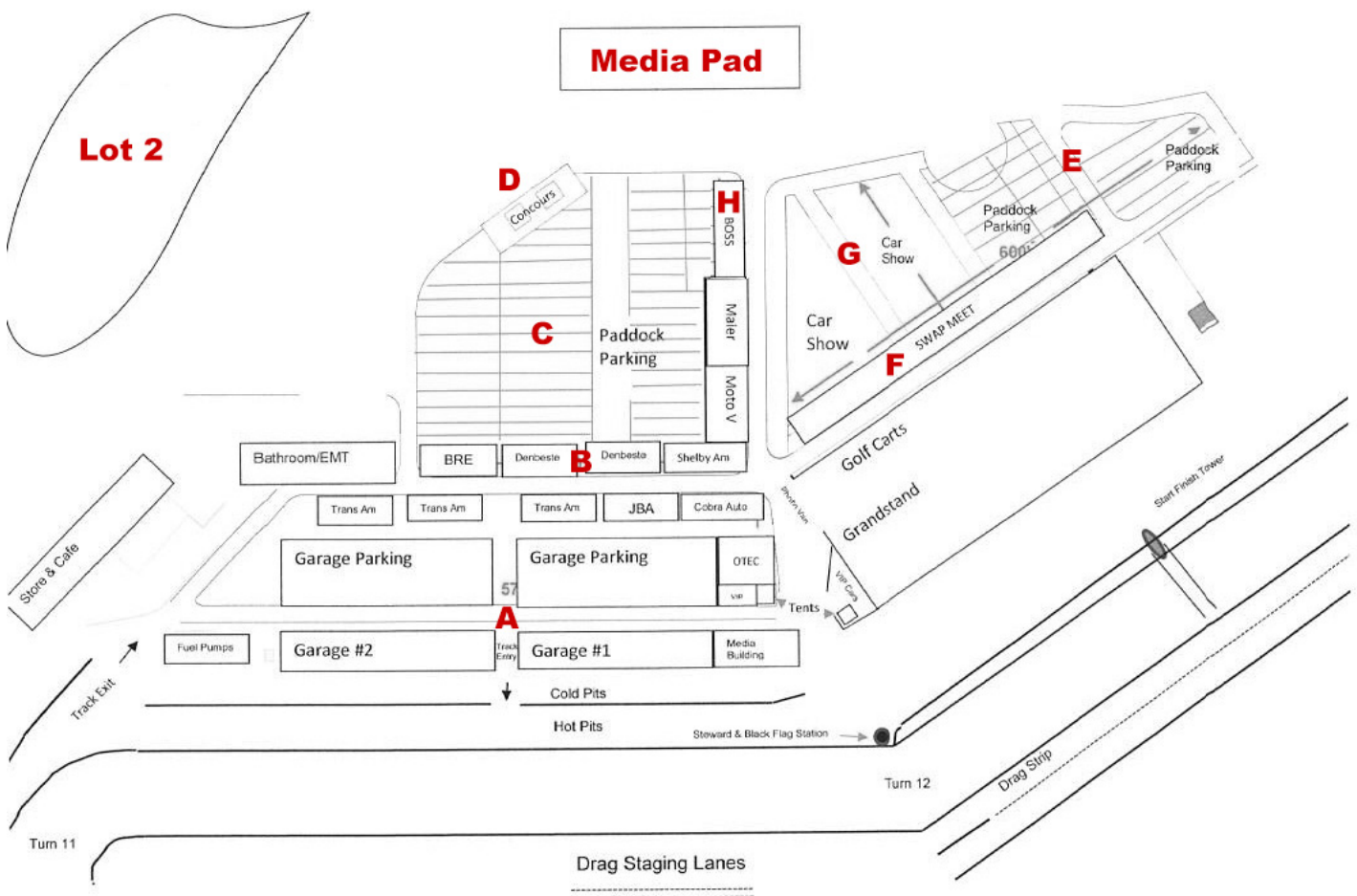


SAAC-50 Parking Guide

SAAC-50 is going to be a well attended event. We're doing our best to ensure we have mapped out and planned space for all our participants and partners. We ask that you follow the directions of our paddock parking staff and be courteous to your fellow attendees.

Please find below the parking directions based on your Registration options. Parking will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations or holding spaces for friends are not permitted. If you wish to be parked adjacent to a specific individual, please arrive at the track together, as you are likely to be situated near each other.

It is important to note that parking availability is subject to various factors beyond our control. *If parking spaces become exhausted, you may be asked to park in a different location than specified below.* While we will do our best to adhere to the established parking hierarchy, with the exception of Garage Renters and Commercial Vendors, all other attendees are subject to potential changes in parking arrangements. Your cooperation and patience in this matter are greatly appreciated.



Area A - Garage Renters:

If you have rented a Garage Lane, you will be emailed your Garage Lane assignment in advance of SAAC-50. Our Staff will also have the list of assignments. Renters will be directed to their assigned Garage Lane. Garage Renters will have the space opposite their Garage Lane for support vehicles if needed. If you do not need your space, please let a SAAC Staff member know so we can make efficient use of the space. Open Trailers will need to be stored up in Lot 2, not in the paddock area.

Area B - Commercial Vendors:

All Commercial Vendor space has been pre-assigned. You will be directed to your assigned space. Since space is limited, we will ask that you occupy as little space as possible.

Area C - Race and Open Track Participants:

If you have registered for Racing or Open Track, you will be asked to park in the main paddock area. Since space is limited, we will ask that you occupy as little space as possible. Open Trailers will need to be stored up in Lot 2, not in the paddock area. When Area C fills, additional Race and Open Track Participants will be asked to park in Area E.

Area D - Concours Participants:

The Concours Judging Area is identified on the Map. Concours participants will be contacted by the concours team regarding parking and trailer storage.

Area E - Parade Lap Participants:

If you have registered for Parade Laps, you will be asked to park in the paddock area behind the main grandstand and to the right of the Car Show area. Since space is limited, we will ask that you occupy as little space as possible. Open Trailers will need to be stored up in Lot 2, not in the paddock area.

Area F - Swap Meet Participants:

If you have registered for Swap Meet, you will be directed to the Swap Meet area of the paddock. Since space is limited, we will ask that you occupy as little space as possible. Open Trailers will need to be stored up in Lot 2, not in the paddock area.

Media Pad - Overnight Camping:

We have set aside dedicated space for Overnight Campers not participating in Racing or Open Track in the Media Pad. Alternatively, campers may choose to park in Lot 2.

Area G - Car Show Participants:

The Popular Vote Car show takes place on Sunday. Participants in the car show will have a dedicated spot for their show vehicle(s). Cars will be loaded in on Sunday morning as directed by Staff. Support vehicles are not permitted in the car show parking area and must be parked elsewhere as described above or in Lot 2. However for both Friday and Saturday, we'd like to use this area as a sneak peek of the car show. Participants in the car show may park their car show vehicle in Area G on both Friday and Saturday. Be aware, vehicles may not be left in Area G overnight.

Area H - Boss Reunion Participants:

Dedicated space for members of the Boss Reunion. Show vehicles only, support vehicles need to be parked elsewhere as described above or in Lot 2.

Lot 2 - General Spectators and other Participants:

If you do not have Racing, Open Track, Parade Laps, or Swap Meet on your registration you will be asked to park in Lot 2. Some exceptions may be made for single day parking of eligible vehicles in Area G as space allows.
