SAAC-50 Parade Lap Guide

Parade laps are an awesome way to experience the thrill of being on the track at speeds that are gentle on your car and body! They're a chance to take a moment to appreciate the beauty of the track and marvel at the engineering that goes into creating one of America's greatest racing circuits. But, like anything involving a vehicle, *safety must come first*. So, please read this guide to make sure you have a safe, enjoyable, and well-prepared experience during your parade laps.

- **1.) All Parade Lap Drivers must attend the Parade Lap Driver's Meeting each day**, prior to enjoying driving on the Track. Check the SAAC-50 track schedule for times. All participants in the vehicle must sign the track waver.
- **2.)** The Parade Lap session is broken into two groups, A and B. Please consult the SAAC-50 track schedule for the exact times each of these groups will be out on-track. Your Group A or B assignment can be found on your Parade Lap Sticker, located in your registration packet. Please affix your Parade Lap Sticker on your Windshield in the top corner on the Driver's side.
- **3.) Pace cars will be in the group to maintain the Track's set speed limit of 35MPH**, and to monitor these guidelines. Do not slow down traffic to create areas on the Track that you can exceed the set speed limit.

Absolutely No Passing.

If you'd like to go faster than the set speed limit, please sign up for Open Track where there are no speed limits.

- **4.)** It is your responsibility to ensure that your Vehicle is in good working condition, there are No leaks, Tires have appropriate tread thickness and inflation. All wheel lug nuts in place and secure, if knock-off hubs, knock-off checked for tightness and have safety wire. The Vehicle's brakes need to be in good working condition. All loose items are removed from the passenger compartment and trunk. Be sure you have adequate fuel in your vehicle for the whole session.
- **5.) If you have a mechanical issue, pull to the edge of the Track**, do not exit the vehicle (unless it is on Fire), remain in the vehicle until Track workers arrive.
- **6.) Do not stop on the track to take pictures or retrieve lost items**. If video is desired, it is recommended that a fixed camera (Go Pro) be used rather than a handheld. No cameras in the Driver's hands, and cameras must remain within the vehicle not outside of the window frame.
- **7.)** No car seats, no small children. Drivers and Riders must meet the Track's required minimum age to be in the vehicle. (Driver's Minimum age is 18 y/o. And Sonoma's minimum for passengers is 16 years of age) Helmets are not required for Parade Laps.
- 8.) No RV's, vans, motorcycles, trikes, or large/lifted off road vehicles.

Failure to follow these guidelines will result in your removal from the parade laps for the duration of the event, without a refund.
